Dear Madam Prime Minister

With each terrorist attack in the UK and elsewhere in Europe, we, families and survivors of the September 11 attacks in the United States, painfully relive the horror others, just like us, experience. Their losses, at the hands of those whose ideology adheres to Saudi sponsored Wahhabism, will endure for the rest of their lives. We know that. We live it every day. It is with heartfelt sympathy for the victims and their families that we watch this unfold over and over again in the UK, in Europe, in Yemen, and in the Middle East.

Over the past 15 years, our quest for justice has led us down the money trail in search of who financed the brutal murder of almost 3,000 loved ones, the injuries of 6,000, and the sicknesses and deaths of many thousands more from 9/11 exposure. Let us not forget the members of our militaries who have sacrificed so much. We are *always* led to the source – Saudi Arabia, who even our former U.S. Secretary of State, Hillary Clinton has disclosed was and is at the center of terrorism funding now spreading all over the world.

The unforgiving form of Islam propagated by Saudi Arabia, with its abysmal human rights record, is the mother of al Qaeda and ISIS. Both have sprung from the deep well of extremism and intolerance disseminated throughout the Muslim world via Saudi financing, recruiting, and inspiring hateful violence. Almost 16 years after 9/11, the extreme, virulent, intolerant brand of Islam disseminated by the Saudis continues to be the heart and soul of terrorism, and money is its lifeblood.

We are not safe from terrorism unless we can cut off its lifeblood and show the British and American people that Saudi Arabia can no longer escape accountability for the violence it sows.

The UK now has the unique historic opportunity to stop this killing spree of Wahhabist-inspired terrorists by releasing the UK's Government report on terrorism financing in the UK which, according to media reports, places Saudi Arabia at its center of culpability. The longer Saudi Arabia's complicity is hidden from sunlight, the longer terrorism will continue. They must be stopped; but who will stop them? We submit that you are uniquely situated to shine the cleansing light of public consciousness.

We respectfully urge you to release the report now, finished or unfinished. We ask you to consider all the victims of state-sponsored, Saudi-financed terrorism, their families and the survivors in the UK and all over the world. Additionally, our democratic

freedoms continue to be compromised. How can the UK public have confidence in their safety if nothing changes?

How many more people must die before Government decides to use its power to protect its people? *You* have the power to alter the course of history, stem the growth of terrorism and ultimately, secure our safety. Please release the report and let truth and justice finally prevail.

We would be very grateful for your response in this most important and urgent matter.
